#### **Activity Instructions**

#### **Discussion points**

When your child is happy with their artwork, explore it with them by asking:

- What colours did you use?
- Why did you choose these colours?

### **DISCOVER THE ARTWORK**

#### Now together, learn about the artwork that inspired this colouring activity!

- This activity is based on the artwork *We are Family* by Vicente Delgado. He was born in Madrid, the capital of Spain. He likes being called Tito!
- The artwork is soft! It is made of soft sculptures that have been sewn together.
- The figures are of different colours-red, yellow, blue and green-to represent the diversity of Singapore. Their eyes, mouths and head are black.
- Which two colours can you mix together to form another colour in the artwork? [Suggested answer: blue + yellow = green]
- The artist shows that these figures are like members of a family. When the family is together, every member is stronger than when they are alone.
- Do you think we are stronger alone or together?
