Programme: SAM Assembly Talks

Programme Description:

This 30-minute assembly programme will educate students about Singapore through an engaging presentation with interactive segments and opportunities to win prizes. The programme references selected artworks from various SAM exhibitions like Learning Gallery, and includes artworks from the STAR MOE binder – Investigating Contemporary Art: SAM. The programme will be facilitated by a museum educator, who offers insight into contemporary art practices.

Objectives and Outcomes:

The programme objectives are:

- 1. To use contemporary art to explore current issues in Singapore
- 2. To expose students to artists and artworks from Singapore.
- 3. To encourage students to reflect on their Singaporean identity through contemporary artworks.

The programme outcomes are:

- 1. Students will gain a better understanding of contemporary issues in Singapore through examining the context and subject matter of contemporary artworks.
- 2. Students will gain knowledge on artworks and artists from Singapore.
- 3. Students' will be more aware of their Singaporean identity.
