

[Fact Sheet] SAM at Tanjong Pagar Distripark

SAM at Tanjong Pagar Distripark (TPD) is spread over two floors, and developed by design and build agencies SPACElogic Pte Ltd, FARM and AE Models Team Pte Ltd.

The first level will have over 2,000 square metres of floor space, containing:

- Two expansive climate-controlled gallery spaces that feature 6-metre-high ceilings, to present large-scale installations and exhibitions;
- A reception foyer that will offer varied art experiences for visitors upon entering the space –
 from encounters with works from the SAM Collection to specially commissioned activations;
- A multi-purpose events space known as The Engine Room which can host outreach programmes for up to 100 pax;
- An F&B space overlooking a view of the port, which also serves as a lounge area for visitors.

The reception area on level one of SAM at Tanjong Pagar Distripark will feature varied art experiences for visitors to encounter upon entering.




From January to August 2022, local art collective vertical submarine will present a new version of *Flirting Point* (2009) in this space.




The gallery foyer at SAM at Tanjong Pagar Distripark.





Gallery 1, one of two expansive gallery spaces in SAM at Tanjong Pagar Distripark with a floor space of about 930 square metres, where large-scale installations and exhibitions will be held. The first exhibition to be presented in this gallery will be an immersive, time-based installation by The Observatory titled *REFUSE*.



Gallery 2, a second gallery with a floor space of close to 240 square metres. This gallery will host its first exhibition by Korakrit Arunanondchai, titled *A Machine Boosting Energy into the Universe*.

The Engine Room, a multi-purpose hall adjacent to the F&B space at SAM at Tanjong Pagar Distripark that is dedicated to events and public programmes. In January 2022, Malaysian artist Gan Siong King will present his work titled *My Video Making Practice* in this space.




The third level has a floor space of over 1,300 square metres and will house the SAM Residencies studios and SAM's corporate office. This arrangement gives SAM staff, residents and the public greater opportunities for social interaction and engagement in these spaces, which include:

- A central, open space known as The Main Deck, which serves as a zone for interaction and to host programmes of the SAM Residencies, such as talks and performances;
- An experimental ideas lab to showcase the development of content, research and processes by staff and residents;
- Artist studios and a shared workspace for SAM residents.
